

## Central All Church Retreat: Frequently Asked Questions

### **How do I get to Montreat, and how long does it take to get there?**

Take I-85N toward Greenville.

Near Greenville, merge onto I-185 North.

Take the 1st exit to US-25, going North towards Travelers Rest.

US-25 merges into I-26 in N.C. - follow signs to Asheville.

Take I-40 East in Asheville.

Exit #64 to Black Mtn /Montreat.

Go left (Rt. 9) through Black Mtn toward Montreat.

Go around the Montreat 'gate' and follow the map on your schedule to Anderson Auditorium.

It is about a 4 hour drive.

### **Can I carpool with someone?**

### **What time should I plan to arrive?**

We begin with lunch at 12:00pm.

### **Where do I go when I get to Montreat? What if I do not know where my lodge is?**

Come to Anderson Auditorium when you arrive, to check in and receive your name tag. We will help you find your way to your lodge.

### **Should I bring food or snacks?**

Please bring your own breakfast food, or coordinate breakfast with people in your lodge.

### **This is my first time coming to Montreat! How will I learn my way around?**

Come to Anderson Auditorium at 12:30pm on Saturday for our "First Timers Orientation," led by David Martyn and Amber Tittle. They will help you learn the ropes!

### **What will I do during free time?**

The options are endless! We will provide some official free time outings, and we encourage you to explore the beautiful Black Mountain and Asheville area.

### **I am a youth or a youth parent. What are the youth doing on the retreat?**
