We began our journey together in December with our opening retreat at Central. Sponsors joined for part of our time together and we focused on what our big faith questions are. Some examples of this include: *How do people (adults) know that God is real? How do you see God at work in your life? Will Jesus ever come to earth again? How do we know what's in the Bible is true? What exactly is church? Is heaven real? What about hell?*

Our opening retreat also included making sandwiches for the OAC guests and serving breakfast in Tull Hall as a way to celebrate that church is a place to be God's hands and feet in the world.

From there, we focused on Sunday School as a time to come together and grapple with some of these big questions, pulling from the <u>Theocademy curriculum</u> to guide our conversations.

Other highlights from this season:

- ★ A meal with Pastor Shannon and Pastor Kate, hosted by the Ashe family, where we got to grill them with some of these tough questions.
- ★ A worship and service opportunity at Holy Comforter Church, a congregation of the Episcopal Diocese that practices radical hospitality, especially to people with acute mental well-being needs.
- ★ Attending Shabbat services at The Temple on April 12th and receiving a tour of the synagogue from Rabbi Peter Berg.





Our spring retreat in March was spent at both Columbia Theological Seminary and at the Bliss family lake house. We were able to focus on fun and fellowship in both places and reunite with our sponsors to kick off the process of writing faith statements. We talked a great deal about how the process of confirmation is just as much about the journey as it is about the destination. And as youth leaders, Courtney Anne and I enjoyed watching this group shop and cook for one another and for us, celebrate Hannah's birthday and lead worship outdoors before returning to Atlanta.

Since then, the confirmands discerned their next steps by writing faith statements with their sponsors and continuing to ask their big questions. We also found joy together in planning this service! Dr. Martha Moore-Keish was a special guest in Sunday School to help us think about why and how we worship.

Every one of these young people have poured energy, imagination, time, reason, and creativity into this experience. We are grateful to be walking alongside them for this chapter of their faith journey and beyond.
