This is a Central-only trip, 1/18 - 1/20: we will start in Montgomery, AL and visit the Equal Justice Initiative and the National Memorial for Peace & Justice. We will stay on 1/18 at Immanuel Presbyterian in Montgomery. On Sunday, 1/19, we'll head to Birmingham for a

tour and service opportunity before spending the night at Living River Retreat Center to relax and debrief our experience. We'll return to Atlanta the afternoon of 1/20. We will be using youth Sunday School time as an opportunity to prep for this experience.
